#### **Trustee**

# **Principal Activities**

The Fund is an unregistered Unit Trust domiciled in Australia that has provided a loan to MAB Corporation Pty Ltd for use as working capital.

# **Review of Operations**

The Fund commenced operations on 8<sup>th</sup> June 2016, and as at 30 June 2017, \$7.68M of equity had been raised by the Fund. During the year ended 30 June 2018 a further \$3.45M of equity was raised, bringing the total invested in the Fund to \$11.13M.

The equity raised was repaid to investors, together with interest accrued, in December 2017 following the completion of the Banksia Development in Docklands.

# **Auditor Independence and Non-Audit Services**

There were no other services received from the auditors in the year ended 30 June 2018.

# NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2018

# 1. Fund Description

The Fund is a Unit Trust domiciled in Australia that has provided a loan to MAB Corporation Pty Ltd ("Borrower") for use as working capital.

# 2. Basis of Preparation

# (a) Statement of Compliance

The Directors of the Trustee have determined that the Fund is not a reporting entity on the basis that, in the opinion of the Trustee, there are unlikely to exist users of the financial report who are unable to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy, specifically, all of their information needs. Accordingly, this financial report is a special purpose financial report, which has been prepared in order to satisfy the financial report preparation requirements of the Trust Deed.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement requirements specified by all Australian Accounting Standards and Interpretations, and does not comply with the disclosure requirements of Australian Accounting Standards.

# (b) Functional and Presentation Currency

The Financial Report is presented in Australian dollars, which is the Fund's functional and presentation currency.

# 3. Significant Accounting Policies

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the Financial Report are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied throughout the year.

# (a) Basis of preparation

This financial report is a special purpose financial report that has been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards.

During December 2017 the Banksia Development in Docklands reached practical completion, at this time all equity raised, together with interest accrued was repaid to investors. Accordingly, the financial report has been prepared on a non-going concern basis.

Under a non-going concern basis of accounting, the recognition and measurement requirements specified by all Australian Accounting Standards and Interpretations have been applied in the context of the company ceasing to be a going concern. As a consequence of ceasing to be a going concern, the application of these requirements may have resulted in the write-down of assets to their recoverable amounts, and the recognition and/or remeasurement of liabilities for obligations that exist at the reporting date.

All balance sheet items are being represented as current due to the expected realisation of the asset and liabilities presented within 12 months of the date of this financial report.

# (a) Basis of preparation (continued)

The financial report was authorised for issue by the Directors of the Trustee on 25 September 2018.

### Historical Cost Convention

The financial report has been prepared under the historical cost convention.

# Critical accounting estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with Australian equivalents to International Financial Reporting Standards requires the use of certain critical accounting estimates. It also requires management to exercise its judgement in the process of applying the Fund's accounting policies.

# (b) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents includes cash on hand, deposits at call with financial institutions, other short-term, highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less that are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value.

# (c) Loans and receivables

Trade receivables, loans, and other receivables that have fixed or determinable payments that are not quoted in an active market are classified as 'loans and receivables'. Loans and receivables are measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method less impairment.

Interest income is recognised by applying the effective interest rate.

### (d) Revenue

Revenue for the Fund comprises of transaction and interest income all of which is recognised in the income statement on an accruals basis. Transaction fees are recorded on the basis of the various agreements to which the Fund is a part to.

### (e) Distributions

A provision is made for the amount of any distribution declared by the Trustee on or before the end of the reporting period but not distributed at the end of the reporting period.

#### Opinion

The Directors of the Trustee have commenced the process of terminating the Fund. All loans receivable have been received and liabilities settled, or transferred to MAB Corporation Limited, prior to 30 June 2018. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.
